Visitor Regulations

Of Leipzig Prison with Hospital

In order to create a pleasant and comfortable atmosphere for all individuals participating in the visit, it is necessary to adhere to the following guidelines and rules.

- Each prisoner can receive up to four hours of visits per month.
- Prisoners up to the age of 21 may receive an additional two hours of visits per month from close family members.
- The duration of a visit is one hour.
- Visiting appointments must always be arranged with the staff of the visiting department.
 - Appointments can be made by phone at 0049 341 8639 205, or you can arrange further appointments directly with the staff of the visiting department during an ongoing visit.

Note!

- If a prisoner is subject to imprisonment-related restrictions on visits, an application
 must be submitted to the responsible court or the responsible public prosecutor's
 office to issue a "one-time visiting permit" for the scheduled visiting appointment,
 or a "permanent visiting permit" for all further visits.
 The "visiting permit" must be presented to the prison staff upon entry to the
- prison.
- Individuals will only be admitted as visitors if their names are listed on the "visitors list" of the respective prisoner. The entry on this "visitors list" is made upon a written request from the prisoner.
- Visiting times can be found in the current information on the homepage of Leipzig Prison with Hospital. <u>Visiting times at Leipzig Prison with Hospital.</u>

- Each prisoner can receive up to three registered visitors (including children) at the same time. Pets are not allowed to visit.
- Children under the age of 14 may only participate in the visit if accompanied by an adult.
- Before the visit takes place, all individuals participating in the visit will undergo a search.
- Entry to Leipzig Prison and hospital must take place no later than 15 minutes before the scheduled visiting time. The planned visit may not be guaranteed if visitors arrive late.
- All visitors aged 14 and above must present an official ID if requested by the prison.
- Visitors are not allowed to bring personal documents, food and beverages, or personal items such as mobile devices, wallets, watches, bags, calendars, and cameras into the visiting area.
 - Bringing any weapons or weapon-like objects (including pepper spray) and legal intoxicating substances (alcohol, cannabis) into the prison is prohibited and may, in individual cases, result in a ban from entering the prison and possibly also a criminal complaint.
 - There is a general ban on smoking during visits.
- No objects may be handed over to the prisoner. Exceptions require prior approval from the prison.
- During visits, visitors may purchase cold and hot beverages as well as snacks from the vending machines for immediate consumption. The necessary coins for this can be brought into the prison after being inspected by the staff of the visiting department.
- Money can be transferred to the respective prisoner's account via the State Justice
 Treasury of Chemnitz. Detailed information can be found on the homepage of Leipzig
 Prison with hospital, or can be obtained from the staff of the visiting department.

- Visits will not be carried out or will be canceled if the individuals participating in the visit (visitors, prisoners)
 - do not comply with the instructions of the prison staff,
 - refuse to undergo a personal search,
 - are suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs,
 - hand over objects, substances, or money (including attempts),
 - behave inappropriately,
 - disturb the general visiting process,
 - are suspected of committing criminal acts.

Note!

- The visit can also be canceled if there is no misbehavior on the part of those involved in the visit, but the order and security of the prison are at that time at risk due to other events (e.g., alarm situations).
- If there is suspicion of criminal acts, a criminal complaint will be filed officially, and the involved visitor will be banned from entering the prison.
- If you, as a relative, wish to obtain information about daily prison life or simply need someone to listen to you, you are invited to contact our <u>relatives' representatives</u> with these concerns. Further information can be found on the homepage of Leipzig Prison with hospital.
